Cold Spring Kennels has made every effort to provide you with a healthy puppy. We guarantee your puppy to be up-to-date on treatments & vaccinations. We make no guarantee of your puppy's mature size or weight. We sell puppies as "Pet Quality" and do not guarantee it will be of show or breeding quality.

Cold Spring Kennels warrants your puppy to be in good health and free from visible signs of infection & contagious diseases for the first 3 days after purchase. We warrant against fatal and life altering congenital defects for 6 months after purchase.

It is the Buyer's responsibility (at Buyer's expense) to have your puppy examined by a licensed Veterinarian within 72 hrs of pickup. If the exam reveals there is a problem, the Buyer must provide the Seller with a written statement from the Veterinarian, on his/her office letterhead, and signed by the Veterinarian, stating the health problem, which includes all symptoms supporting the diagnosis. Failure to do this will result in the cancellation of this warranty. The puppy must be returned, in good health (at the Buyer's expense) within 24 hours of the examination and with all registration papers giving ownership back to the Seller. If you choose euthanasia without the Seller's prior consent you will forfeit all warranties in this contract. We only offer puppy replacement, using a puppy from comparable "Dam" & "Sire".

We **DO NOT** warrant "Common Puppy Problems", which usually occur within 2 weeks after purchase. Most of these problems are stress related and should clear up quickly after you and your puppy get used to your new life together. These common puppy problems include:

- Kennel Cough: (coughing, hacking, sneezing and a runny nose) the cough may linger several weeks. You treat this with antibiotics. Your puppy is vaccinated, however, there is a chance that the puppy will get Kennel Cough.
- Diarrhea: Diarrhea can occur from stress, change of diet/water, or any change of environment.
- Lack of Appetite: This may occur for the first few days. If your puppy is not eating, you may add a little Plain non-fat Yogurt or Canned Wet Food to the dry food.
- Crying: Most puppies will go through a period of adjustment when they join a new family.

Please do not take your puppy into public places until the puppy has had all of its vaccinations (as recommended by your veterinarian) to insure immunity against disease. The Buyer is responsible to safe-guard his puppy's health and obtain medical treatments when necessary, and follow Veterinarian guidelines for vaccinations and de-worming. The Seller will not be responsible for any medical expenses incurred with a Veterinarian.

Any physical problem which is or could be the result of injury is not covered under this warranty.

All sales are final except for those Warranties contained in this contract.
